

**Scholarship Applicants Must:**

- Be a 2019 graduate of a local-area high school or home-school program.
- Plan to attend the 2019 fall semester or 2020 spring semester at an accredited community, state or private college or a licensing vocational trade school (real estate training courses do not qualify).
- Demonstrate stable scholastic achievement (majority A and B; C is acceptable, but no grades lower than a C on report cards for the current school year).

**A minimum of 20 \$1000 Scholarships will be awarded** based on the merit of the essay submitted and paid directly to the college or trade school of your choice

**“Integrity in Service”** is this year’s scholarship theme.

**Application Process** (follow these instructions exactly as outlined):

- 1) Go to [www.ClickFamilyFoundation.org/essay](http://www.ClickFamilyFoundation.org/essay). Click the “Retrieve your Essay ID” button. Enter a personal code word. Do not include any part of your name in the code word. Write down your Essay ID and personal code word or click the “print” button. The information will be needed later in the process. Click “Register” to submit your registration.
- 2) Write a minimum 500-word essay about someone whose life of integrity and service to others has impacted your personal life philosophy. Your essay file must be a Word (.doc or .docx) or PDF file.

As we are a relatively small community, it is of high importance that **your identity and identity of the person about whom you are writing remain anonymous** until winning essay IDs are posted on our web site.

In your essay, please do not include any identifying information. Instead, refer to the person about whom you are writing in a general way such as mom or dad, friend, grandparent, brother/sister, coach, pastor, teacher, etc.

- 3) Save your essay using your Essay ID as the file name.
- 4) When finished, go to [www.ClickFamilyFoundation.org/essay](http://www.ClickFamilyFoundation.org/essay). Click the “Upload Files” button. Follow the screen instructions. Your Essay ID and personal code word are needed to upload your essay.

**Scoring:** 75% content of essay; 25% spelling, grammar and punctuation. Please check spelling, grammar and punctuation before submitting.
